# A YEAR OF GROWTH, IMPACT, AND NEW OPPORTUNITIES IN ARCHITECTURE

Architecture plays a crucial role in shaping our communities and enhancing our daily lives. By providing resources and educational programs, MAF fosters awareness and a deeper appreciation for architecture's impact.


In 2024, we achieved outstanding success in advancing this mission, exceeding expectations in our fundraising efforts to support scholarships, grants, and educational initiatives.

This year, MAF awarded \$44,000 in scholarships to twelve exceptional students from the University of Detroit Mercy, University of Michigan, Kendall College of Art & Design, and Lawrence Technological University. We also proudly introduced the Hamann² Fund, a new scholarship honoring Norm Hamann Jr. and his late father, Norman Hamann Sr. This scholarship is awarded to students pursuing a professional architecture degree while integrating business courses into their elective studies, reflecting the importance of blending design with business acumen. In addition to scholarships, MAF provided nearly \$40,000 in grants through our Education Awareness, Evans Graham, Farrell Architectural Awareness, and Fellows Fund for Equity (F2E) grant programs.

The F2E grant, established in 2024, is dedicated to newly licensed Black, Hispanic, Native American, and other underrepresented architects who are actively practicing. This grant helps reduce student debt and/ or reimburse expenses related to licensing exams while recognizing excellence, creativity, and perseverance. Adopted by the Michigan AIA College of Fellows, the F2E grant aims to diversify the profession by fostering connections between recipients and Michigan AIA Fellows and local AIA Chapters. Our inaugural recipient, Anne Doornbos, a dedicated architect and current President of the Grand Rapids AIA chapter, exemplifies the impact this fund can have. We are excited to see the continued growth of this initiative—thank you to Elisabeth Knibbe for championing this important addition to MAF's mission!

2024 also brought change to MAF. Angela Jeruzal, who has played a pivotal role in supporting our mission, has embarked on a new professional journey. While we will miss her dedication and commitment, we are excited for her next chapter. On behalf of everyone at MAF, we extend our heartfelt thanks to Angela for her years of hard work and invaluable contributions.

As we reflect on 2024, we take great pride in the impact MAF has had. Looking ahead to 2025, we remain committed to expanding opportunities that showcase the power of architecture to create deep emotional connections with the spaces we inhabit. We will continue our mission to promote, perpetuate, and preserve architecture as an art form, ensuring its enduring influence for generations to come.

# REVIVING A PIECE OF BLACK EDEN

# HISTORIC HOTEL CASA BLANCA RECEIVES 2024 EVANS GRAHAM PRESERVATION GRANT



First Neighbor LLC and their project, the Historic Hotel Casa Blanca in Idlewild, Michigan, is the 2024 MAF Evans Graham Historic Preservation Grant recipient. The \$20,000 grant will assist in stabilizing and weatherproofing the structure. Post-renovation, the redeveloped 35-room Hotel Casa Blanca will serve as a bed and breakfast with conference rooms. The venue will also feature a heritage and learning center.

Idlewild, often referred to as 'Black Eden,' served as a haven for Black Americans during segregation and the Jim Crow era. Visitors would flock to Idlewild for recreation, relaxation, entertainment, and social activities typically not available to them in their home cities.

### THE EVANS GRAHAM PRESERVATION AWARD

The Evans Graham Preservation Award grants provide financial assistance to groups and individuals seeking to preserve Michigan architecture. The \$20,300 Award is granted by a jury annually to a single project based on the merits of the project.

The Award was created in 1998 to honor the memory of preservation architect David Evans, FAIA. Ralph and Jeanne Graham, co-founders of the award, guided its development until their passing; the Award was re-named in 2015 to honor their leadership and contribution. Applications are evaluated by the Evans Graham Preservation Award jury.

# INSPIRING YOUNG IMAGINATIONS

# MAF K12 PROGRAMMING -FREE EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR KIDS

Studies show thought processes that nurture creativity and critical thinking begin at a young age. The Foundation's free educational-based resources have been developed to foster those processes while stimulating children's curiosity through fun activities that appeal to young students.

- 1. **ARCHITECTURE: IT'S ELEMENTARY!** is a multi-disciplinary educational curriculum designed to introduce students from kindergarten through grade five to architecture and the built environment. Developed with input from Michigan educators, the curriculum provides kids with critical STEAM-related learning opportunities, through lessons and activities that engage their minds, bodies, and imaginations
- 2. **ARCHITREKS** is a video program aimed at getting kids excited about architecture, science, and engineering through segments that take kids on neighborhood adventures to explore shapes, structures, landmarks, and preservation, and pique curiosity about their surroundings. Created in partnership with Detroit Public Television (DPTV), each of the ArchiTreks video segments airs on the Michigan Learning Channel (MLC).
- 3. **BUILD IMAGINATION BOOK AND TOY KITS** help to stimulate children's imaginations and lead them to explore architecture through reading and creative play. The Build Imagination Toy Kits are available at select libraries throughout Michigan. The Build Imagination Book Collection is housed at Birmingham's Baldwin Library and available to borrow statewide through the intra-library loan system.

### FELLOWS FUND FOR EQUITY GRANT






In 2024, MAF launched the Fellows Fund for Equity (F2E) Grant. The grant is intended to help reduce remaining student debt and/or as reimbursement for expenses associated with the licensing exams, while at the same time, awarding performance, creativity and perseverance. The F2E grant is specifically for newly licensed Black, Hispanic, Native American (and other individuals from underrepresented groups) architects who are actively practicing architecture.

In addition to monetary assistance, this one-time grant includes mentorship with a Michigan-based member of the AIA College of Fellows. The grant committee is chaired by MAF board member Elisabeth Knibbe, FAIA.

In its inaugural year, MAF awarded its first F2E to Anne Doornbos, AIA, NCARB, LEED AP. Anne is a Project Architect for TowerPinkster in Grand Rapids, and is very active with the AIA Grand Rapids Chapter as well as 2025 AIA Grand Rapids Chapter president.





# REFLECTING ON A FRUITFUL YEAR

### YEAR IN REVIEW

In 2024, MAF continued to fulfill its mission to advance awareness of architecture with grants, scholarships, events, and programming that helped make the lives of Michigan residents better through architecture. In addition to the 2024 MAF programs and initiatives and their impacts featured throughout this report, here are additional MAF highlights from the past year:

**MAF 2024 EVENTS**. MAF hosted events that brought people together to socialize, celebrate, and raise funds for MAF programming. The 2024 events included the following:



[1] 'A Visit to Damian Farrell's Wine Cellar'. Great wine, delicious food, and exceptional company were on the menu at the April 6 event to honor the late MAF board member and support the MAF Damian Farrell Architecture Awareness Grants. The event raised \$14,000.



[2] 'Brick by Brick – Foundation for the Future'. The May 16 event, hosted by MAF and AIA Grand Rapids, raised \$14,000 to support the AIA Grand Rapids student scholarship fund endowment.



[3] 'Fore a Great Cause' Golf Outing. The 2024 outing, held on May 20 at Plum Hollow Country Club in Southfield, brought supporters together for a fun afternoon of golf, networking, and to raise money for scholarships and education programs. The event raised nearly \$33,000 in total.



[4] Auction for Education. This annual event, which features two separate live auctions (during the Fore a Great Cause Golf Outing in May, and during the AIA Michigan / AGC Michigan Midsummer Conference) raised \$20,000 in 2024. Each year, auction items are donated by MAF's generous supporters.



### **FAREWELL TO A DEDICATED SUPPORTER**

Longtime MAF board member Leslie D. (Les) Tincknell, FAIA [5], passed away on January 17, 2024. Les was instrumental in building and growing the foundation, and served on the MAF board for 30 years, in roles including president and treasurer. As treasurer, under Les' financial leadership, MAF's endowment more than quadrupled. In 2016, Les received MAF's Leadership Award.











### **EXPLORING MICHIGAN'S ARCHITECTURAL**

TREASURES To help promote awareness and interest in Michigan architecture, MAF again featured its popular summer architecture road trip article series. Stops [6] included historic Detroit, Ann Arbor, West Michigan, and the Upper Peninsula, as well as Southeastern Michigan and Northwestern Michigan.

CELEBRATING ARCHITECTURE, GRANTS, AND COMMUNITY In 2024, MAF published eleven newsletters highlighting grants, scholarships, recipients, Michigan architecture, donor profiles, events, tours by complementary organizations, and the popular holiday gift guide. 




